

THE LINDA MAINPRIZE TOYS FOR TICKETS PROGRAM

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is helping make the holidays a little brighter for less fortunate families by allowing parking ticket payments to be made with a donation.



Parking tickets issued between December 1 and 17, with this flyer, are eligible to be paid by donation. Gifts must be in original packaging with no batteries or glue required. War toys will not be accepted.

The value of the donation must be equal to or exceed the amount owed on the Parking Infraction Notice. Proof of purchase and the Infraction Notice must be presented at the time of donation.

Donation suggestions: new unwrapped children's toys; Non-perishable food items such as canned fruit, vegetable, soups, stews; clothing for infants and children and gift certificates for teenagers.

There is a 3-hour limit for on-street parking year round without a permit.

Winter Parking Restrictions take effect December 1 through to and including March 31. There is to be no parking between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. so that snow can be cleared from the streets.

Any vehicle without valid license plates parked on a street or in a Town parking lot, will be tagged and towed as an abandoned vehicle.

Winter Parking Tips

Parking on both sides of the streets restricts access for emergency vehicles and snow plows. Help us keep the roads clear by NOT parking directly opposite a car that is already parked on the road. It is very difficult and sometimes not possible to get our emergency vehicles and snow plows through cars parked this way on our residential streets. Vehicles blocking snow plows or salters will be ticketed for interfering with snow removal.

How can you help us? When parking, ask yourself if your vehicle will block the passage of an emergency vehicle or snow plow. If yes, please move your vehicle. Wherever possible, please park in your garage or fully on your driveway. When it snows and if possible, please try to remove your vehicle off the road. Help us keep the roads clear, safe and easily accessible.



Do not park directly opposite another vehicle on the other side of the road.



Do not park your car this way anytime. You will get a ticket.
