



Whitchurch - Stouffville Museum

TRUST AGREEMENT

Subject to additional proceeds from the Advanced Funding Program (Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario) being awarded to the Friends of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum covenants and agrees to purchase in trust for the Friends of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum,

- (a) a photocopier, and
- (b) research workstations and display cabinets for the Bogartown Public School

subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. THAT, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum may use the above equipment to contribute to the administration, promotion and fund raising efforts for the Museum; and for the provision of work space for cataloguing, conservation and research activities by staff, volunteers and the visiting public as it sees in the best interest of conserving the Museum's collection of artifacts and providing public service in accordance with the Museum's statement of purpose;
2. THAT, upon dissolution of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum, the above-mentioned property obtained from the proceeds of the Advanced Funding Program administered by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario will be returned to the Friends of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum to be distributed to one of the following organizations, listed in preference:
 - a) another charitable organization operating a museum in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville;
 - b) another charitable organization operating a museum in the Regional Municipality of York;
 - c) another charitable organization operating a museum in the Greater Toronto Area;
 - d) another charitable organization operating a museum in Ontario;
 - e) another charitable organization operating in the Regional Municipality of York.
