The Vandorf Public School (SS No. 2) is just one of six designated heritage buildings on site at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum. It was constructed in 1870 and used as a school until 1956. The building was then used as a local police station before becoming part of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum in 1978. The Vandorf PS building is the only heritage building to have been built on the Museum grounds; all the other buildings have been moved to the Woodbine Avenue site.
