Family Stick & Puck is a casual way to practice the fundamentals of hockey – shooting, passing and basic stick handling. Hockey helmets are mandatory for this program (for both Adults and Children) and scrimmages are not permitted. This program provides an opportunity for children and their parents to play together. Children are not permitted on the ice by themselves and no adults are permitted on the ice without a child. **Max. 3 children per an adult.**

Family Stick & Puck has a maximum capacity of 20 people and it is a first serve basis.

Important Information

- **CSA approved hockey helmets are recommended for all recreational skaters.**
- All public skates are monitored by Town Staff.
- CSA approved hockey helmets with a full-face mask and full equipment are **mandatory** for Youth Shinny.
- CSA approved hockey helmets are **mandatory** for Adult Stick & Puck and Adult Shinny. Full face mask and full equipment is strongly recommended.

What to Expect from Public Skate Reopening

1. All drop-in programs are now **pre-registered**. Registration closes at 4:00 pm the day before the program, no exceptions. Weekend program registration will close by 4:00 pm on the Friday before. If the program is cancelled, then you will be unable to register for that timeslot. **All drop-in fees are non-refundable.**
2. Sign-in will start **30 minutes prior** to the program's start time.
3. Upon arrival, please enter through the Arena front door. Check in with the staff person working and show your completed Screening (refer to "**Mandatory Screening Upon Entry**" section below)
4. All participants must use hand sanitizer or wash hands upon arrival
5. Masks must be worn upon arrival and may only be removed when the activity is being played.
6. Please come dressed for your activity. Change rooms may be available. Please limit the number of personal items you bring to your programs to only the essentials. Spectators are permitted but there is a capacity max.
7. We recommend participants bring their own equipment.
8. Participants must keep social distancing in mind during play.
9. At this time, we are not selling nor accepting any 10 pass tickets. Kindly hold on to prior 10 tickets for future use.
10. **Family Skate Program** – All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a full vaccinated adult. No individuals under this age will be allowed to attend without an adult (over the age of 18 years old). ALL participants must be registered.
11. **Parent and Tot** – Each tot must only be accompanied by one adult at this time. Accompanying adult does not need to register ahead of time.

Mandatory Screening Upon Entry

As of Wednesday, September 22nd, 2021 as per section 2.1 of Schedule 1 to O.Reg 364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at Roadmap Exit Step (O.Reg. 364/20) under the reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 (ROA), the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will require each patron who enters an area of the premises to provide at the point of entry, every time enters:

- **Proof of Identification**
 - Driver's License, Health Card, Passport, or Government/Military Issued ID
- **Proof of FULL vaccination against COVID-19**
- **Complete Town of W-S Screening tool indicating entry verification**
 - Must display the green check mark with current date of use

Any of the above items can be displayed via hard copy or via cell phone photo, provided all necessary information is clearly visible
