



Household Battery Recycling Program

Residents are now able to drop-off their used and unwanted household batteries in the bins provided at the following facilities:

- Stouffville Clippers Complex, 120 Weldon Road
- Stouffville Arena, 12483 Ninth Line
- Whitchurch-Stouffville Leisure Centre, 2 Park Drive



Batteries are considered hazardous waste and are not accepted with regular waste collection. Please drop-off your batteries to be recycled.

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR BATTERIES FOR RECYCLING

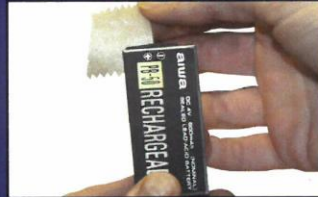
It is important that batteries be prevented from short circuiting



Lithium



Button Cell



Rechargeable



6 & 9 Volt

Step 1: Round up your used batteries.

Step 2: To avoid the possibility of a short circuit, use masking tape to cover the terminal ends of all lithium, button cell, 6 & 9 volt batteries. See examples above.

Step 3: Place batteries inside THE BATTERY RECYCLING CONTAINER.
