Things to KNOW



Helpful Reminders

Vehicles are not allowed to park on any road between the hours of 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. from December 1 to March 31 of each year.

Please do not to push snow from your driveway onto the travel portion of your road.

Please place green bins, blue boxes and garbage bags/containers in driveways rather than on snow banks or on the road.

When driving, stay well back of snow plows. Never pass a snow plow.



Regional Roads

The Region of York is responsible for clearing snow on regional roads, which include Woodbine Ave., Warden Ave., Kennedy Rd., McCowan Rd., Highway 48, Ninth Line, York Durham Line, Davis Dr., Vivian Rd., Aurora Rd., Bloomington Rd., and Stouffville Rd.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville provides snow clearing and sanding during the winter season for all sidewalks within the Communities of Stouffville, Ballantrae and Gormley.

The plowing and sanding of sidewalks commences when snow accumulations are five (5) centimetres or greater. The plowing and sanding is normally completed within twenty-four (24) hours after the end of a snowfall. The Town will

re-sand sidewalks, as required, to avoid icy conditions after snow clearing is complete.

Residents are reminded to please not block the sidewalks with their vehicles during the winter months.

The Town does not maintain sidewalks on private property such as condominiums and commercial properties, or on the Town's trail system.

Snow Plowing on Town Roads

Snow plowing is carried out in accordance with the classification of roads. Arterial roads such as Main Street and the Tenth Line receive preferred services at all times.

Normal plowing operations of arterial, collector and local roads take approximately (8) hours to complete after the end of a snow storm. Generally the plowing of arterial and collector roads will be in progress before the plowing of local roads commence.

At the beginning of a snowfall, the arterial and collector roads are salted and the local roads are sanded at hills, curves and intersections.

Generally, the plowing of roads commences after the accumulation of five (5) centimetres of snow.

All cul-de-sacs are plowed. Snow will be pushed to the centre of the cul-de-sac and will remain there until time permits clean-up or the area for snow storage becomes limited.

Windrow Clearing

The Town provides residential sidewalk and windrow snow clearing for seniors and physically challenged residents where there is no able bodied person

living in the household at no cost. Application forms are available on the Town's website or from Customer Service.
