TOWN INTRODUCES NEW ACCESSIBLE WASHROOM/CHANGE ROOM TRAILER

Committee takes steps to make community events accessible to all

WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE, ON – The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is happy to introduce its new barrier-free, fully-accessible washroom on June 30th, 2018 at the Stouffville Strawberry Festival.

With the dedication of three community advocates - Diane Ward, Wilf Morley and Derek Bunn who have been fundraising for over a year to accumulate funds to acquire the fully-accessible trailer, paired with the generous contribution of \$50,000 from the Federal Government through the Enabling Accessibility Fund (EAF), the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville was able to purchase the washroom/change room trailer for community events.

On Friday, June 30th at 6 p.m. the Town will have the official ribbon cutting ceremony at Memorial Park. The Town is excited to showcase the washroom and make it available for public use during this years Strawberry Festival. This new addition will allow community members with disabilities to entirely participate in community events such as festivals and fairs.
