TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE RECEIVES FEDERAL AND PROVINCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS **Funds will subsidise Stouffer Street water & wastewater improvements**

WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE, ON – The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has received a grant for \$555,814 from the Federal Government and \$277,907 from the Provincial Government as part of the Government of Canada’s Clean Water and Wastewater Fund (CWWF).

The funding for the Town will go towards the replacement of the Stouffer Street water main and sanitary sewer, and for improvements to the storm sewer system.

“The water and sewer pipes have served the residents of Whitchurch-Stouffville well for more than 60 years; however, they are reaching the end of their lifecycle and need to be replaced,” says Rob Flindall, Director of Public Works for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

Construction for Stouffer Street is anticipated to begin in July 2017 and be completed by the end of the year. Storm sewers will be installed to replace drainage swales and driveway culverts from Montreal Street to 10th Line, while the water main and sanitary sewer from Millard Street to Montreal Street will also be replaced.
