COULTICE PARK'S GRAND OPENING JUNE 17

WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE, ON – The grand opening of Coultice Park is set to take place on Saturday, June 17 at 10 a.m.

The event will kick off with a ribbon cutting ceremony with Whitchurch-Stouffville Mayor Justin Altmann and Council, the Coultice Family, the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority, landscape architect Landscape Planning Ltd., and park contractor Latitude 67 Ltd.

“We are thrilled to provide the residents of Mussleman’s Lake with a community park,” said Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Leisure and Community Services Director, Rob Raycroft. “After a decade of intense research and planning, Coultice Park has finally come to fruition. We have thoroughly taken into consideration residents’ wants and needs in a neighbourhood park and I believe they will be very happy with this.”

The park land, donated by the James Coultice Estate, is approximately 5 acres in size within the Community of Mussleman’s Lake. Amenities were selected based on public consultation which include a children’s playground, splash pad, fitness equipment, an accessible washroom, and parking lot.

Parking for event will be available at the Cedar Beach parking lot; however, residents who live close by are encouraged to walk to the park located at 14769 Ninth Line. This is a rain or shine event.
