TOWN MANAGER OF LAW ENFORCEMENT PASSES AWAY **Linda Mainprize worked for municipality for 17 years**

WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE, ON – Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Council and staff are sad to share the news of the recent passing of our Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement, Linda Mainprize. Linda passed away suddenly on Saturday night.

“On behalf of the Town and Council, I offer our deepest condolences to her family and friends,” said Town Chief Administrative Officer Roman Martiuk. “She played a large role here and the news has had a profound effect on our family here at the Town.”

Linda started her career at York Regional Police and worked as a By-law Enforcement Officer for the Town of Richmond Hill prior to joining the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in 2001 as a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer / Property Standards Officer.

Linda was then appointed Senior Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and then Manager in 2015. Most recently Linda was also acting as Manager of Customer Service.

“Linda was like no other. She was extremely hard working, but she always had a smile on her face,” Martiuk said. “Linda loved what she did for a living and always had the best interest of the Town’s citizens at heart.”

“This is devastating news for our Town, for our office and for her family. We are all shocked by the news,” Martiuk said.

Flags at all Town facilities will fly at half mast from Monday June 4 until Friday June 8 in honour of Linda.

Linda will be greatly missed by all Town staff and Council.
