

Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library Announces Start of Curbside Service

Whitchurch-Stouffville, ON, June 3, 2020 – The Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library will be resuming partial operation via curbside pick-up service beginning June 9, 2020. Curbside service includes all material excluding magazines and items from the local history collection.

Customers are now able to place holds online through wsplibrary.ca. When holds become available, library staff will notify the customer when they can pick up their material.

“We look forward to providing this service for our community,” says Margaret Wallace, WSPL Chief Executive Officer. “We have listened to our customers when they indicated they would like access to physical library materials and are now comfortable that we have taken all necessary precautions to ensure this service runs effectively and safely.”

Curbside service hours will be held on Tuesday and Saturday from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. and Thursday from 3-7 p.m. The curbside service will operate from the exterior entrance of the Library, located at 2 Park Drive. There will be no public access to the building and library staff ask that customers observe social distancing protocols and when possible, wear a mask when using the service.

Due dates have been extended for all items and the outdoor drop boxes remain closed.
