

Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library Announces Phase Two Reopening

Whitchurch-Stouffville, ON, July 9, 2020 – The Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library will launch phase two of its staged reopening plan on July 21, 2020. This phase will allow customers entry into the Library to use computer, photocopier, and printing services.

Customers wishing to use Library computers will have to make a reservation and will be granted a 45-minute block of computer time per day, per Library card. At this time, no gaming is allowed. Computers and computer equipment will be cleaned and sanitized before the next reservation block to ensure public safety.

“We are excited to re-open our doors to our community,” says Margaret Wallace, WSPL Chief Executive Officer. “The need for library services has been felt by our residents and we are delighted to welcome them back into our beautiful facility.”

The Library’s curbside pick-up service will move inside the Library on July 21st with customers able to enter the library facility to pick up items placed on hold. Customers can place items on hold online using the Library’s catalogue or by calling the Library. Note that as of July 17 all holds notifications will be moving to email only; no phone calls (unless specified in the library card user information) will be made.

The Library’s phase two hours are Tuesday: 10:00-1:00pm (holds pickup) and 3:00-7:00pm (computer bookings), Thursday: 3:00-7:00pm (holds pickup and computer bookings), Friday: 10:00-1:00pm (holds pickup and computer bookings) and Saturday: 10:00-1:00pm (holds pickup and computer bookings).
