### WATER BILLS

**DUE DATE – Friday, December 4**

WATER bills have now been mailed. If you do not receive your bill please contact our Customer Service Centre. Failure to receive a water bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of water or the penalty charge for late payment.

WATER PAYMENTS may be made by mail, at most Financial Institutions, banking machines, by telephone and internet or in person at the Municipal Offices. After hours, water payments may be made in the drop box at the main entrance of the Municipal Offices. For inquiries, please contact Customer Service.

**PLEASE NOTE: The Town will no longer accept credit cards for payment of your water accounts.**

### MUNICIPAL ENCROACHMENTS

The Public Works Department reminds residents that the Town is **not** responsible for any damage caused during our winter maintenance operations to items such as gardens, fences, posts, interlocking brick work, concrete and wood curbs etc. that have been placed on Town property.

Removal of these items would aid with the road and sidewalk plowing operations and prevent damage to these property improvements. The Town, at its discretion, may request the removal of these obstructions.

### YARD WASTE COLLECTION



**An Additional Yard Waste Collection has been scheduled for the week of November 23<sup>rd</sup> on your regular collection day.**

Please ensure all materials are placed curbside prior to 7:00 am on collection day. Crews will not return for late set-outs.

All yard waste material except brush **must be placed in paper yard waste bags or an open top garbage can only (labelled yard waste)**. Clear, opaque or orange bags will not be collected. Yard waste materials will also not be collected if set out in a blue box, contractor pails or cardboard boxes.

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will not pick up leaves that have been raked or piled along roads. Non-containerized or non-bagged leaves present a traffic, drainage, and safety hazard. In addition, leaves can block culverts and roadside catch basins, and may cause flooding. Residents are asked to please help to keep these areas free of excess leaves.

Additional yard waste can be taken to the Bloomington Composting Facility after this date. Please refer to the 2015 Waste Collection Calendar for location and hours.

### NO OVERNIGHT PARKING December 1 to March 31 inclusive

Parking rules ensure that our streets are clear to accommodate traffic flow, emergency vehicles and winter maintenance.

**Parking is prohibited on Town streets between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m.**
