Leisure Centre **\$150**
Training Sessions: 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM

The Assistant Counsellor Program empowers youth to step into leadership roles and gain real-world experience in a supportive camp environment. Participants develop practical skills in communication, teamwork, problem-solving, behaviour guidance, and activity facilitation; skills that translate directly into future summer employment, volunteer opportunities, and leadership positions both in and out of camp.

Through hands-on mentorship from experienced staff, Assistant Counsellors learn how to lead groups, support camper needs, create engaging activities, and contribute to a positive and inclusive camp culture. Many participants use this program as a pathway to becoming future Camp Counsellors, Supervisors, or leaders within their community.

To participate, youth must attend mandatory training and submit two reference letters. Participants aged 16+ are also required to submit a Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) from YRPS. All documentation must be provided prior to the training dates.

A minimum two-week commitment is required to ensure a consistent and meaningful learning experience.

Hours worked in the camp setting as an Assistant Counsellor can also be applied toward your high school volunteer hours requirement.







These will be accommodated first. Starting March 2, 2026, you may request 1:1 support for additional weeks on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Once support staff is confirmed, Inclusion Services will contact you to complete camp registration, take payment, and confirm your camp selection. Note: 1:1 support registration is separate from camp program registration.
3. Complete the Inclusion Camper Profile form at townofws.ca/inclusionsupport.
4. Staff can arrange facility tours, information sessions, and meet-and-greets before camp begins.

How do I know if additional support is required?

Extra support may be required for camp participation if:

- Extra support is required at school in the classroom.
- A physical, development, and/or learning disability exists.
- Extra support is needed at home for basic care (toileting, feeding, changing, etc).

Camp Hours and Extended Care

- Camp hours vary based on location. Extended care is available at certain locations for an additional cost.
- Before Care runs from 7:30 – 9:00 AM and After Care runs from 4:00 – 5:30 PM.



Sign In & Out Procedures, Safe Arrival and Dismissal

All parents/guardians are required to sign their child in and out of camp daily. Only individuals who are listed on the designated camper pick up list will be able to pick up campers. Photo ID will be required at each pick up.



Medication

If a participant is required to take medication, please ensure you indicate this through the custom questions upon registration. You will then need to follow the procedure below:

1. All medications must be in their original bottle with the child's name clearly indicated and dosage.
2. Only send the correct dose for the day.
3. Campers must self-administer their medication with staff supervision.



Anaphylaxis and Epi-Pens

If your child requires the administration of an Epi-Pen, please ensure you indicate this through the custom questions upon registration. Participants who require Epi-Pens are responsible for ensuring that they have their Epi-Pens with them while attending camp. Epi-Pens must be carried by the participant, in a waist pack that is easily identifiable. Campers must self-administer their Epi-Pen with staff supervision.



Behaviour Guidelines

The Town of Stouffville is committed to ensuring a safe and inviting environment for all participants in our recreation programs, including summer camps. Parents/guardians will be notified if behaviour expectations are not being met. Serious behaviours are classified as those that compromise the immediate safety of oneself, staff, volunteers, and other participants. These will require immediate action from camp staff to ensure the safety and quality of programs provided.

Behaviour Colour Chart



Action:

Bringing electronics to camp, being disrespectful to staff or another camper, taking something that is not theirs.

Result:

Verbal warning given to camper.



Action:

Bullying (repetitive unwanted actions towards another person), acting with inappropriate intentions, deliberately putting self or others at risk.

Result:

Phone call home to parent/guardian.



Action:

Physical bullying, threats, bringing weapons to camp, stealing from another camper.

Result:

Parent/guardians will receive a call and camper will be sent home. Depending on the severity of the situation, police may be called and the camper removed from camp.
