Council will recognize the Finance team on their Certificate of Recognition for Budget Preparation from the Government of Finance Officers Association.



Council will receive a presentation from town planners regarding Additional Residential Units (ARUs) and other matters in the Greenbelt and Oak Ridges Moraine Area.



Council will receive a deputation from Dennis Van Zevenbergen, Director of Property and Environmental Services, Parkview and Susan Pethick, Parkview Resident, requesting a traffic light at Parkview North entrance.



- 8 Council will be asked to bring forward a by-law to establish property tax rates and levies for 2025.
- 9 Council will be asked to approve a special service tax levy imposed on the Downtown Stouffville Area based on the 2025 Budget and an additional levy requested. This amount may then be added to the 2025 final tax bills.

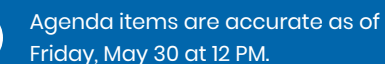


- 1 Council will be asked to select an option for waste collection for businesses located in the downtown village area, bounded by Albert St. and Park Dr.

- 3 Council will be asked to endorse a recommendation for the Province to consider permitting ARUs within the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan (ORMCP) and the Greenbelt Plan Area.
