Responsible for assisting instructors with swim lessons, including escorting program participants to and from changeroom in an orderly manner, cleaning and tidying changerooms and pool deck areas, responding to routine inquiries, monitoring, and supervising changeroom activities, and for assisting with program delivery as required/directed.

Responsible for monitoring and supervising swim activities as assigned, including: coordinating instructors and lifeguards, ensuring pool equipment and materials/supplies are set up prior to start of programs, performing lifeguarding and/or instructional duties, checking and recording enrollment and attendance, maintaining statistics and associated paperwork, participant liaison duties, reporting/resolving problems as appropriate, providing feedback to supervisor on employee performance and training needs, ensuring program content meets departmental standards, and coordinating emergency rescue and reporting as required.
