- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with program participant and the general public

2. Lifeguard - Job # 2022-123

Position Purpose:

The Lifeguard is responsible for the provision of instruction for assigned aquatics programs, including participant liaison duties, statistics compilation, ensuring pool maintenance complies with health regulations and for assisting with registrations, program design and other associated duties as required.
