Reporting to the Chief Information Officer, the Systems Developer is responsible for the development, implementation, operation, support, and maintenance of a portfolio of enterprise business systems. The Systems Developer will work closely with other IT resources on supporting enterprise systems infrastructure; and facilitate the integration of data from a variety of business applications. The Systems Developer will work collaboratively with business users, vendors, and other IT resources as part of a cross-functional project team to optimally configure and deliver new application solutions to the organization.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- University degree in Computer Science or equivalent combination of relevant experience and education in a related field.
- Minimum 5years of progressive work experience in the Information Technology field with an emphasis on enterprise system solutions implementation, administration, and technical support
- Extensive work experience with IT business systems infrastructure and architectural design, client-server & web applications, web servers (IIS, Tomcat, Apache), API integration frameworks and application integration.
- Expert knowledge of T-SQL, Reporting Services (SSRS), and Integration Services (SSIS).
- Advanced working knowledge in data engineering and designing and developing ETL solutions. Experience with FME would be considered an asset.
