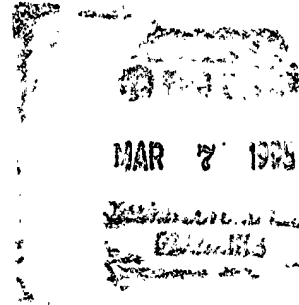


Please be advised that the above-noted matter was placed before Council Public Hearing at its meeting held on February 28, 1995.

BY-LAW NUMBER 95 - 39

A by-law to designate a certain property
as being of Historic and/or Architectural
value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29, Subsection 6 of the Ontario Heritage Act, Chapter 0.18, R.S.O. 1990, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate a real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic and/or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises as outlined hereunder:

Christian Church,
6528 Main Street,
Stouffville, Ontario
L4A 5Z4

and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the Stouffville Memorial Christian Church, Lot 1, Concession 9, former Township of Whitchurch, more particularly described as Lots 22 and 23 on Registered Plan 230, municipally known as 6528 Main Street, Stouffville, and has caused notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;


AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the following real property, being the Stouffville Memorial Christian Church, municipally known as 6528 Main Street, Stouffville, being in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in the Regional Municipality of York, being Lot 1, Concession 9, former Township of Whitchurch, more particularly described as Lots 22 and 23 on Registered Plan 230, be designated as being of historic and/or architectural value or interest.
2. THAT the Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described herein in the Land Registry Office.

READ a first and second time this 28th day of February, 1995.

READ a third time and passed this 28th day of February, 1995.
